It is to inform that the Medical Assessment and Rating Board (MARB) reviewed the Assessor's Report dated 12.01.2023 and thereafter compliance dated 31.01.2023 submitted by the college regarding faculty, their experience, publication and other teaching facilities including infrastructure available at Andhra Medical College, Visakhapatnam under NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijaywada in the state of Andhra Pradesh for increase of seats in MD – Anaesthesiology for the academic year 2023-24.


The Medical Assessment and Rating Board (MARB) has made the following decision: -

*The college in response of show cause notice dated 31.01.2023 send the compliance report on 31.01.2023. The Compliance report reviewed by MARB Review Committee and satisfied with the compliance and approved 03 seats from 18 to 21 as per NMC guidelines. The MARB hereby withdraw its letter of disapproval dated 13.07.2023 which was issued due to non-submission of compliance but later on, it was found that the college has already submitted their compliance report on 31.01.2023.*


1. The applicant should provide all infrastructural facilities in terms of teaching and non-teaching staff, buildings, equipment and hospital facilities as per National Medical Commission norms.
2. No student should be admitted in the above courses till the formal permission of the Medical Assessment and Rating Board (MARB).
3. The Private Medical College Should Provide Bank Guarantee of required amount against increase of **03 seats** in favour of National Medical Commission, New Delhi valid for three years or till the course is recognised, whichever is later, from a nationalized/ scheduled Bank as per NMC/MCI's norms. However, medical colleges/institutions governed by the State Govt. are required to furnish only an undertaking **signed by Govt. Authority** to provide funds in their budget till the facilities are fully provided as per time bound programme indicated by them.
4. The Medical Colleges/ institutions will provide undertaking to implement the decision regarding payment of stipend to the PG students similar to PG students of Govt. Medical Colleges in their State.
5. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board (MARB) reserve the right to withdraw/cancel/revoke the Letter of Intent/ Letter of Permission if it comes to the notice that the permission has been obtained from Medical Assessment and Rating Board (MARB) by misrepresentation of fact or fraud.

It shall be incumbent upon the Medical College that the information relating to admission should be submitted within the time specified in the circular in this regard issued by this office from time to time. Any failure to submit the information within this time limit would be construed that the admission in the College were not in accordance with the statutory requirements, thereby enabling the Commission to proceed in accordance with law against the college.

Action to grant formal permission of the Medical Assessment and Rating Board (MARB) for increase in intake/starting of the said course at your college will be initiated on receipt of appropriate bank guarantee, if applicable and undertaking/ compliance letter fulfilling the conditions enumerated above.

The acceptance letter may be sent **within one week** from the date of issue of this letter to enable the Medical Assessment and Rating Board (MARB) to issue Letter of Permission for the academic year 2023-24.
